HEALTH ADVISORY

Oceania Cruises strongly encourages guests to practice good hygiene by washing one's hands frequently and thoroughly with soap and warm water. Procedures are in place on board to disinfect and sanitize public areas including door handles, railings, and elevator buttons. As a courtesy to fellow travelers, we ask that guests consider wearing a mask if they are experiencing upper respiratory issues to help prevent the spread of colds and infections between guests.

A NOTICE ABOUT OUR MENUS

Menus for all restaurants are available to view from the Dining & Menus section of the Interactive TV in your stateroom. Guests with dietary restrictions should inform our Reservation staff in the Terrace Café and the Reservation Desk on Deck 5 or contact any of our Head Waiters or the Restaurant Manager.

ALCOHOL POLICY

The minimum drinking age for all alcoholic beverages is 18 years of age. This is the minimum age for Europe and no parental consent is required. A \$25 corkage fee will apply to wines purchased ashore for consumption in the onboard restaurants and bars, and there is a 6-bottle limit per stateroom.

GENERAL ANNOUNCEMENTS

General announcements are made in public areas (lounges and guest corridors) and they can also be heard on channel 25 in your stateroom. Announcements other than those for emergencies and crew safety drills are not broadcast into staterooms.

INTERACTIVE TELEVISION SYSTEM (ITV)

Your suite or stateroom is equipped with a state-of-the-art interactive television system. A wide array of programming is offered for your enjoyment, including movies and TV series, as well as the Cruise Director's daily program available on-demand. You will find information on Destination Services, Entertainment & Enrichment and Aquamar Spa + Vitality Center as well as Speaker Series presentations, a digital version of the daily *Currents* and more. Your ITV provides convenient access to information about the ship and your voyage, such as your onboard account and bar and restaurant menus, all in the comfort of your suite or stateroom.

UNATTENDED PERSONAL ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Leaving any personal electronic devices/appliances plugged in without supervision is strictly prohibited, as this is a fire hazard. The Housekeeping Department will unplug any devices found in violation of this policy.

BIG-O ACTIVITY POINTS

During your voyage, you can earn Big O Points by participating in a variety of exciting activities hosted by your Entertainment Team.

Indoor & Outdoor Sports Activities: First place earns three points; second place earns two points; and third place earns one point.

PURCHASING BRITISH POUNDS ON BOARD

The local currency in United Kingdom is the British Pound (GBP). British Pounds may be purchased at Reception on Deck 4 using your onboard account. The rate is: GBP 1.00 = U.S. \$1.35. A 5% service fee is applicable. British Pounds currency cannot be purchased or accepted to close your onboard account after 10 pm, May 2. Bills of British overseas territories (Gibraltar, Falklands, St. Helena, Ascension and Tristan da Cunha) are not accepted. We do not accept coins.

SEDER DINNER | PASSOVER

A Seder ceremony will take place on April 23 at 6:30 pm in Terrace Café, located on Deck 9 followed by a dinner buffet. This is by reservation only; sign up at the Reception Desk on Deck 4 no later than 10 am on April 23.

THE MEDICAL CENTER

Sirena has a fully equipped Medical Center staffed by doctors and nurses. All ships meet and exceed the guidelines established by the American College of Emergency Physicians/Cruise Ship Medicine section. These guidelines call for emergency medications and supplies to manage common medical emergencies. Onboard services include basic medical treatment, common laboratory tests, EKGs and X-Rays. Hospitalization and Intensive Care Units are available for the stabilization of most cases. We have a well-equipped pharmacy stocked with the most common prescription medications available. Serious medical conditions will require a referral and possible evacuation shoreside if the medical staff cannot treat it on board. The back page of *Currents* lists our current consultation hours. Stateroom visits are also available upon request. Medical personnel are on-call 24 hours a day for emergencies. Please note all medical services are subject to charge.

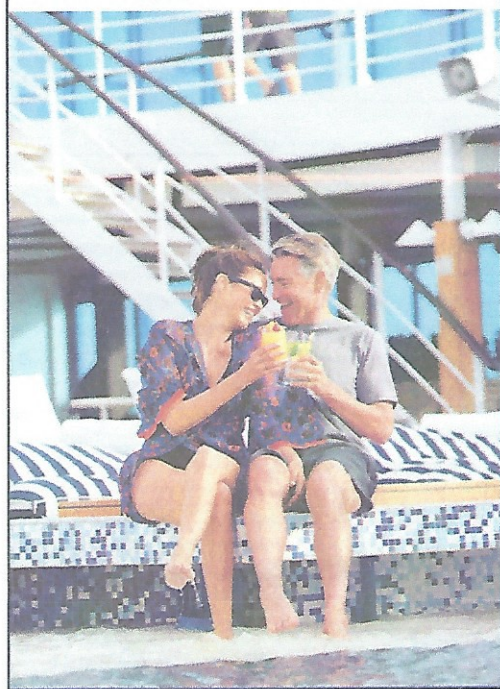

The City of Edinburgh Council governs one of Scotland's 32 local government council areas. The council area includes urban Edinburgh and 30 square miles of rural area. Located in the southeast of Scotland, Edinburgh lies on the east coast of the Central Belt, along the Firth of Forth, near the North Sea. The city was one of the major historical centers of the Enlightenment, led by the University of Edinburgh, helping to earn it the nickname Athens of the North. The Old Town and New Town districts of Edinburgh were listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1995 in recognition of the unique

character of the Medieval Old Town and the planned Georgian New Town. It covers both the Old and New Towns together with the Dean Village and the Calton Hill areas. There are over 4,500 listed buildings within the city. In May 2010, it had a total of 40 conservation areas covering 23% of the building stock and 23% of the population, the highest such ratios of any major city in the UK. In the 2011 mid-year population estimates, Edinburgh had a total resident population of 495,360. The city hosts the annual Edinburgh Festival, which is a series of separate events running from the end of July until early September each year. The longest established festival is the Edinburgh International Festival, which first ran in 1947. The International Festival centers on a program of high-profile

theater productions and classical music performances, featuring international directors, conductors, theater companies and orchestras. The number of visitors attracted to Edinburgh for the Festival is roughly equal to the settled population of the city. The best-known of these events are the Edinburgh Fringe, the largest performing-arts festival in the world; the Edinburgh International Festival; the Edinburgh Military Tattoo; and the Edinburgh International Book Festival. Other annual events include the Hogmanay street party and the Beltane Fire Festival. Edinburgh attracts over one million overseas visitors a year, making it the second most visited tourist destination in the United Kingdom.

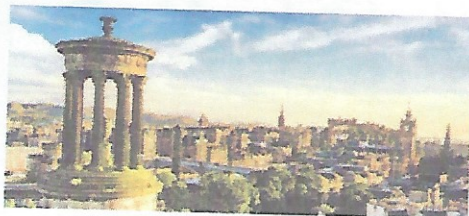

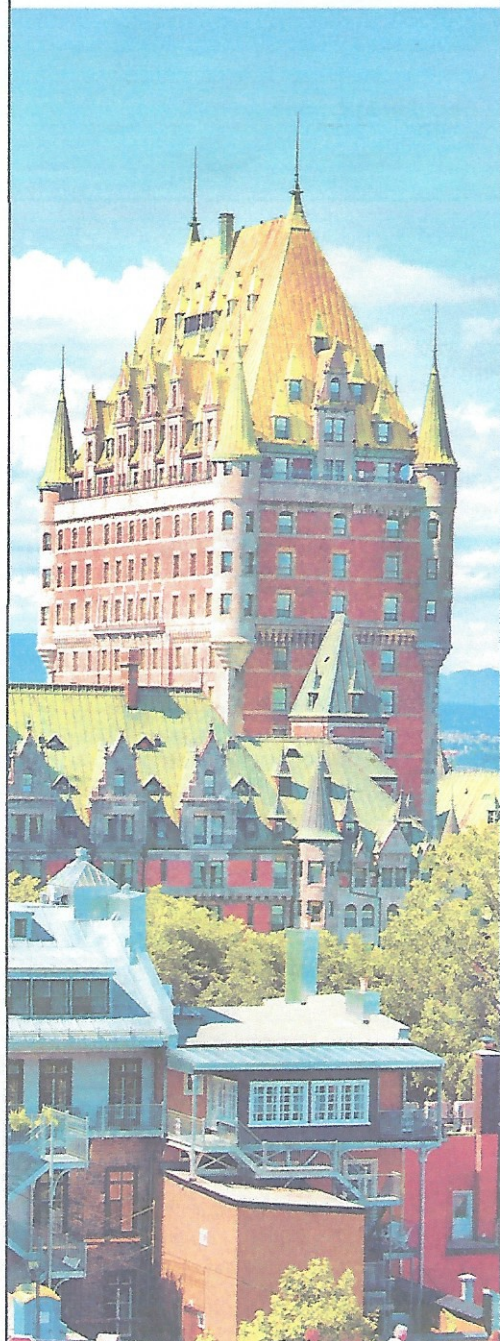

EXPLORE KIRKWALL (ORKNEY ISLANDS)

Kirkwall is the main settlement of the Northern Isles and capital of Orkney, an archipelago in the north of Scotland, as well as the most populous island settlement in Scotland. The city is first mentioned in Orkneyinga saga in the year 1046 when it is recorded as the residence of Rögnvald Brusason the Earl of Orkney. Kirkwall dates back to Norse times when it was called Kirkjuvagr (Church of the bay). At that time the sea lapped at the steps of the cathedral, but now much land has been reclaimed. In 1486 Kirkwall was granted Royal Burgh status by King James III of Scotland. Kirkwall's skyline is dominated by the magnificent St. Magnus Cathedral. Known as The Light of the North, visitors can enjoy guided tours of one of the finest examples of medieval architecture to be found in Britain. Close by, Earl's and Bishop's palaces provide a chilling reminder of Orkney's turbulent past, while at the Orkney Museum in Tankerness

House you'll learn much more about the islands' history and enjoy a leisurely stroll in its delightful walled gardens. The most attractive part of Kirkwall is the central alley, which starts as Bridge St by the harbour, turns along Albert St., then widens into Broad St. with the Cathedral and palace ruins. The street then narrows again to the alley of Victoria Street. Just west of the center, circumnavigate the Peedie Sea: once a tidal inlet, it's now been enclosed into two freshwater lagoons. Kirkwall's manufacturing activities include boatbuilding and the processing of local agricultural produce – whisky distilling, egg packing, creameries, beef, and cheese making. The exploitation of North Sea oil and the building of a landfall terminal at Flotta in Scapa Flow, 12 miles (19 km) to the southwest, has led to some development of offshore servicing and supply for the oil industry at Kirkwall. The town functions mainly as a commercial and

service center for the Orkney Islands and is also the islands' historic county town. A visit to Kirkwall will also give you the opportunity to indulge in one of the nation's favorite pastimes - shopping! However, in Orkney the experience is anything but routine and whether you are looking for essential supplies or that special gift to take home Kirkwall's thriving town center is alive with character and originality. Orkney remains an inspiration for the island's creative community with local jewelry, arts, crafts and contemporary fashion sold by independent retailers and designers. Orkney's streets are refreshingly free from the usual high street names. Artisan bakeries, quality butchers and privately owned grocery stores ensure visitors and residents alike have a wide choice of the finest local and international produce to enjoy.

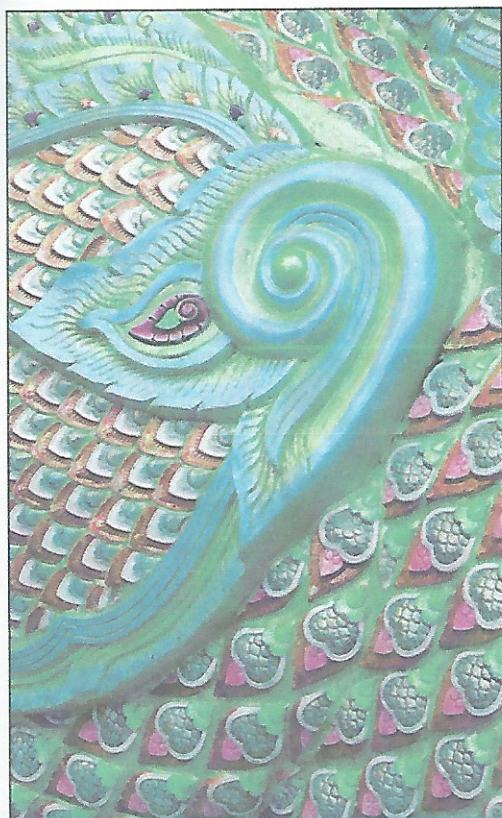

EXPLORE STORNOWAY (HEBRIDES)

Stornoway, Gaelic, Steornabhagh, is a burgh, and the largest town and port of the Outer Hebrides islands of Scotland. It is the chief town of Lewis, on the Island of Lewis and Harris. It is part of the Western Isles council area and the historic county of Ross-shire in the historic region of Ross and Cromarty. The quickest sea crossing from the mainland takes about 3 hours from Ullapool and there is air service from Edinburgh, Glasgow and Inverness. With a local population of 8000 people, Stornoway grew from the 18th Century as a fishing town, but herring fishing has declined. Today, tourism is important to the local economy. The town is a center for the manufacture of Harris Tweed as well as the commercial and administrative center

of the Western Isles council area.

In the town of Stornoway, travelers will find a cosmopolitan and welcoming community with shops, restaurants and accommodation.

In Stornoway the soft smell of peat travels on the air as breezes blow in across the minch onto the hustle and bustle at the water's edge. Local fishermen unload their catches to be transferred to the town's smokehouses. Galleries celebrate community art and many a walker passes through Stornoway, edged by picturesque woodlands for the nature lovers.

Another tradition in Lewis is the famous Harris Tweed. Though it takes its name from its neighbor, Lewis is the center of production. Harris Tweed must be made

from virgin Scottish wool that is woven by hand in the homes of local weavers.

These weavers have defended and protected this historic process, even in the face of developing technologies. Power-looms would speed up production, however weavers staunchly resisted having their labor relocated from their homes to warehouses. The traditional practice enabled them to balance weaving with crofting, tending livestock and cutting peat. This flexible and adaptive way of life is what enabled the Outer Hebrides to thrive. The result of this historic process is a fine quality clo-mor or big cloth, once favored by aristocracy and the landed gentry. To this day, the name Harris Tweed is synonymous with the finest designs.

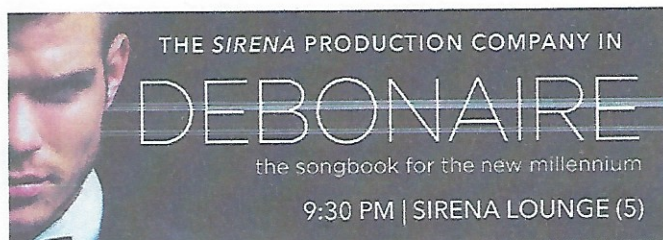


EXPLORE GLASGOW (GREENOCK)

Trendy stores, a booming cultural life, fascinating architecture, and stylish restaurants reinforce Glasgow's claim to being Scotland's most exciting city. After decades of decline, it has experienced an urban renaissance uniquely its own. The city's grand architecture reflects a prosperous past built on trade and shipbuilding. Today buildings by Charles Rennie Mackintosh hold pride of place along with the Zaha Hadid - designed Riverside Museum. Glasgow (the "dear green place," as it was known) was

founded some 1,500 years ago. Legend has it that the King of Strathclyde, irate about his wife's infidelity, had a ring he had given her thrown into the River Clyde, (apparently she had passed it on to an admirer.) When the king demanded to know where the ring had gone, the distraught queen asked the advice of her confessor, St. Mungo. He suggested fishing for it—and the first salmon to emerge had the ring in its mouth. The moment is commemorated on the city's coat of arms. Today Glasgow is a vibrant cultural center and a commercial hub, as well as a launching pad from which to explore the rest of Scotland, which, as it turns out, is not so far away. In fact, it takes only 40 minutes to reach Loch Lomond, where the other Scotland begins. As cities go, Glasgow is contained and compact. It's set up on a grid system, so it's easy to navigate and explore, and the best way to tackle it is on foot. In the eastern part of the city, start by exploring Glasgow Cathedral and other highlights of the oldest section of the city, then wander through the rest of the Merchant City. From there you can just continue into the City Center with its designer shops, art galleries, and eateries. The medieval landscape of buildings such as the Bishop's Castle, the Auld Pedagogy, the Black and Greyfriars and the Old College, which dominated the medieval High Street for hundreds of years, now lie hidden beneath Glasgow's Victorian architecture and new developments. In the past few years, restaurants have been popping up all around Glasgow that emphasize the best that Scotland has to offer: grass-fed beef, free-range chicken, wild seafood, venison, duck, and goose - not to mention superb fruits and vegetables. You can taste traditional dishes, regional specialties and local produce, like haggis, shortbread, whisky and cullen skink. EXPLORE BELFAST

Belfast in the early 20th century had the largest and most productive shipyard in the world, gaining global renown with the launch of the RMS Titanic. Located on the slipways where she was built is a stunning new museum, opened in time for the 100th anniversary of Titanic's only voyage and tragic demise. Today the city and riverfront are undergoing a 21st century transformation, but many exuberant Victorian and Edwardian buildings still sport the carved heads of kings and queens. Belfast, the capital of Northern Ireland lies on Belfast Lough, at the mouth of the River

Lagan on Northern Ireland's east coast. With a population of nearly half a million people, Belfast is Northern Ireland's largest city. The port of Belfast is Northern Ireland's principle maritime gateway. It is also home to the world's largest dry dock and the Harland and Wolff shipyard, famous for building the Titanic. Northern Ireland, with an area of 5,463 square miles, is also known as Ulster because it comprises six of the nine counties that used to constitute the former province of Ulster. Northern Ireland enjoyed a reputation for science, innovation and was a leading force in the Industrial Revolution. Industries like rope-making, linens and shipbuilding created an economic powerhouse. Wealth from the period is reflected in stately Edwardian and Victorian architecture found throughout Belfast. The city is once again a driving force into the future. The economy is thriving and Belfast is reinventing itself. Donegall Square is the heart of Belfast. Most of the main streets of the city radiate outward from the square and it is home to City Hall. The vast rectangular Edwardian City Hall has an elaborate tower at each corner and a central copper dome that rises to a height of 173 feet. Outside City Hall is the Titanic Memorial standing as a poignant reminder of the ill-fated liner built in the nearby Harland & Wolff shipyard. As you explore the city, keep an eye out for "the murals." These somewhat troubling freelance works appearing on building walls provide insight into the period known simply as "The Troubles." Popular art played a conspicuous role in proclaiming the loyalties of Belfast's conflicting communities. The gable ends of houses were decorated and painted with vivid murals expressing affiliations. They remain today as a much photographed part of Belfast's past. Traditional cuisine in Ireland is simple and wholesome, Irish stew being an example. Shellfish, homemade vegetable soups, fish and chips are typical fare. Northern Ireland is well known for its breads. Boxty is a traditional Irish potato bread, made pancake thin and often served with a savory filling. Soda, currant and wheaten bread are also favorites. Pub lunches are popular and Belfast has a wide variety of restaurants including some of the best in Ireland. Irish Whiskey is perhaps the most famous, and then there's Irish coffee. Guinness, a dark heavy stout with a creamy head is the popular beer served at room temperature. The prime shopping areas are located near city center and at Donegall Place and Castlecourt Centre. Items of interest include: souvenirs, quality woolens, hand-knit sweaters and tweeds, Tyrone Crystal, Belleek China, hand crafted Celtic jewelry, Irish linen, music, Guinness products, chocolate and confectioneries.

EXPLORE DUBLIN

Dublin, meaning "town of the hurdled ford", is the capital and most populous city of Ireland. The English name for the city is derived from the Irish name "Dubhlinn", meaning "black pool". Dublin is situated near the midpoint of Ireland's east coast, at the mouth of the River Liffey and the center of the Dublin Region. Similar to the cities of Cork, Limerick, Galway, and Waterford - Dublin is administered separately from its respective County with its own City Council. The city is listed by the Globalization and World Cities Research Network (GaWC) as a global city, with a ranking of "Alpha-", placing Dublin among the top 30 cities in the world. Dublin has many landmarks and monuments dating back hundreds of years. One of the oldest is Dublin Castle, which was first founded as a major defensive work on the orders of

King John of England in 1204, shortly after the Norman invasion of Ireland in 1169, when it was commanded that a castle be built with strong walls and good ditches for the defence of the city, the administration of justice, and the protection of the King's treasure. Largely complete by 1230, the castle was of typical Norman courtyard design, with a central square without a keep, bounded on all sides by tall defensive walls and protected at each corner by a circular tower. Sited to the south-east of Norman Dublin, the castle formed one corner of the outer perimeter of the city, using the River Poddle as a natural means of defence. One of Dublin's newest monuments is the Spire of Dublin, or officially titled "Monument of Light". It is a 121.2 meters (398 ft) conical spire made of stainless steel and is located on

O'Connell Street. It replaces Nelson's Pillar and is intended to mark Dublin's place in the 21st century. The spire was designed by Ian Ritchie Architects, who sought an "Elegant and dynamic simplicity bridging art and technology". During the day it maintains its steel look, but at dusk the monument appears to merge into the sky. The base of the monument is lit and the top is illuminated to provide a beacon in the night sky across the city. Many people visit Trinity College to see the Book of Kells in the library there. The Book of Kells is an illustrated manuscript created by Irish monks circa 800 AD. The Ha'penny Bridge; an old iron footbridge over the River Liffey is one of the most photographed sights in Dublin and is considered to be one of Dublin's most iconic landmarks.

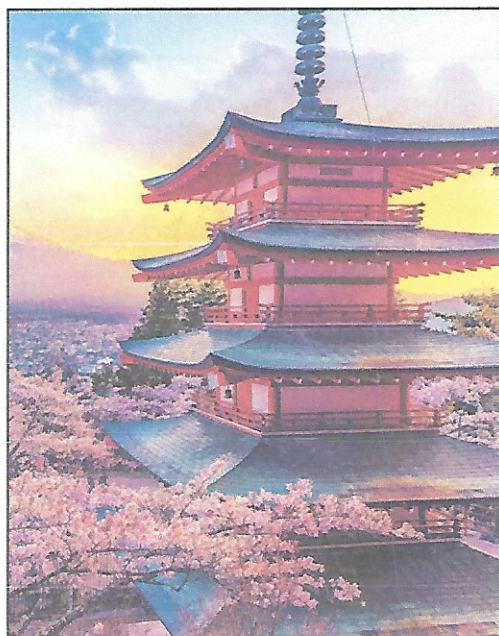

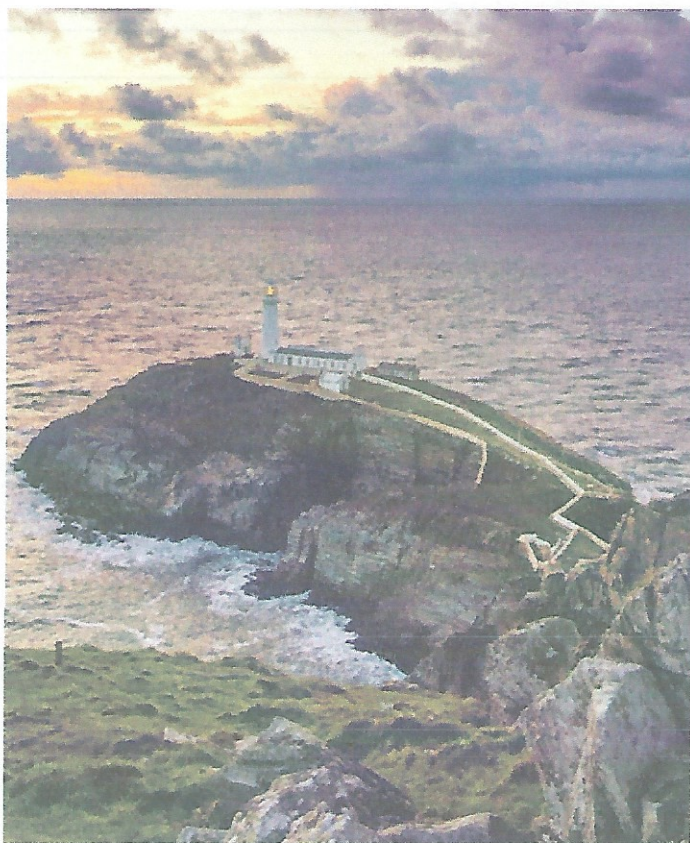

Golf courses are numerous and some have as backdrops, beautiful views of the mountains of Snowdonia. Holyhead is also the cruise gateway to discover the majestic scenery of North Wales. Evidence of inhabitants on the island of Anglesey can be dated to the Mesolithic period, approximately 7000 BC. There are numerous standing stones, burial chambers and fortresses from this era that still exist today. By the first century AD, Rome invaded and occupied the island, which was one of the last strongholds of the Celts. The Middle Ages were a time of great conflict. After the Romans, the Saxons, Vikings and Normans invaded Britain. Also during this period, the Celtic Christian church spread throughout the region. St. Cybi's Monastery was founded at what is now Holyhead and many churches were built across the island. Conflict arose between Wales and Britain during the 13th century. Castles were constructed to defend against invaders from within and without mainland Britain. Acts of Parliament between 1536 and 1543 unified Wales with England. With the coming of the railways and modern ferry service, Holyhead developed into a busy port and the largest town on the island. Today, Holyhead is best known for its ferry service routes to Ireland. Tourism is growing fast as visitors come to Holyhead as the gateway to discover Northern Wales. Traditional Welsh cuisine is intertwined with the land, sea and the unique climate of Wales. Fresh fish from the lake or sea, lamb from the rolling green hills, and fresh vegetables from gardens make up the basic ingredients of Welsh cuisine. An edible seaweed is used to make laverbread, which is often served rolled into small cakes and fried into patties with eggs and bacon. Cockles are a type of shellfish that are also often served at breakfast. Welsh Rarebit is made with melted cheese on toast. Cawl is a rich stew made with bacon, Welsh lamb, leeks and cabbage. Caerphilly is a mild crumbly white cheese, originally from the south of Wales. There are a wide selection of Welsh beers, ciders and perries (pear ciders) to choose from. Wales has a long history of spirit distillation and the region produces many fine blends of whisky. The Port of Holyhead is located close to Holyhead town center where the best shopping is located. Items of interest include nautical items, woolens, clothing, Celtic jewelry, pottery, hand carved wooden items and Welsh souvenirs. The origins of the city of Liverpool date back to 1207, when King John issued letters patent advertising the establishment of a new borough - 'Livpul'. Soon after, in 1235, the building of Liverpool Castle was completed. This stood on the spot where the Victoria monument now is (on the aptly named Castle Street) and was removed in 1726.

EXPLORE HOLYHEAD

Holyhead is the largest town on the island of Anglesey located in North Wales. The rocky spine of an island extends into the open waters of the Irish Sea. Holyhead's ideal location has resulted in the town developing into a very busy ferry port serving as a vital link between Britain and Ireland. The town of Holyhead offers a bustling shopping and visitor's district and has many interesting attractions that draw people from all over the world. The island is a center of modern Welsh culture and is home to a number of historic sites. Whether you are looking to enjoy an active or relaxing holiday, the isle of Anglesey has an impressive variety of outdoor activities. There are excellent fishing and sailing facilities and an extensive network of walking and biking paths. Anglesey is well-known for its beaches and water sport activities.

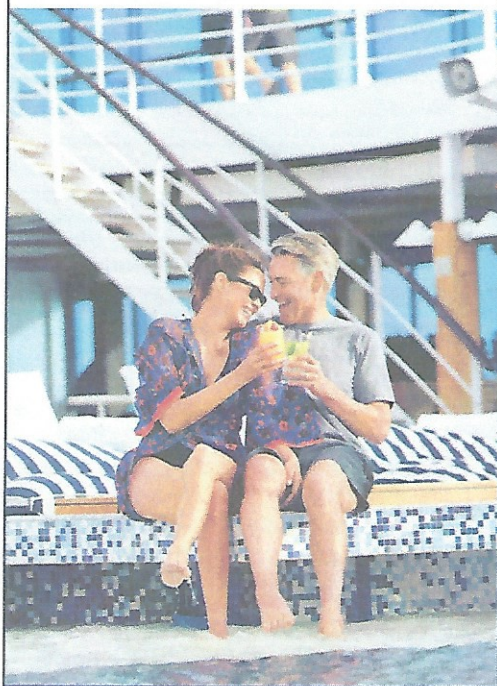

Dining: Order Irish stew flavored with stout. Or try boxty, a potato pancake with onions.

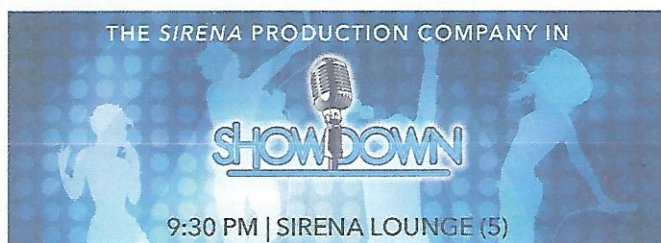
EXPLORE CORK (COBH)

The Republic's second city, Cork (Corcaigh, "marshy place") is strongly characterized by its geography. The center sits tight on a kilometer-wide island in the middle of the River Lee, while the enclosing hills seem to turn this traditionally self-sufficient city in on itself. Given this layout and its history, it comes as no surprise that Corkonians have a reputation in Ireland for independence of spirit, not to say chippiness. Indeed, in many ways, Cork sees itself not in second place but as a rival to Dublin. It produces its own national newspaper, The Irish Examiner, brews Murphy's and Beamish, its own versions of the national drink, stout, and supports a vigorous artistic, intellectual and cultural life of its own. Even its social divisions match Dublin's: here too the south side of the river is generally more affluent, while the north side has more

public housing and a stronger working-class identification. In colonial times, Cork also maintained its own strong links with London, through its role as a major port, proof of which can still be seen all around town. The main drag, curving St Patrick's Street, was originally a waterway lined with quays, while you can still spot eighteenth-century moorings on Grand Parade. Though contemporary Cork doesn't make the most of its long riverfront, much of which is now lined by major roads, the channels of the Lee, spanned by more than twenty bridges, break up the cityscape and pleasantly disorientate. The harbor area has Ireland's largest concentration of chemical factories, fortunately downstream of the center, while the city's other main modern industry, computers, is linked to the prestigious university, to the west of the center. All of this has

spawned a widespread commuter belt, but the compact island is still the place for the many excellent restaurants, lively pubs and artistic venues. The best of the city's sightseeing options are the Crawford Art Gallery, with its fine collection of eighteenth- to twentieth-century art, Cork City Gaol, which vividly evokes life in a nineteenth-century prison, and the hi-tech cosmological displays of Blackrock Castle Observatory. In truth, however, none of Cork's sights are absolute must-sees, though it's a pleasant place to stroll around on a fine day. The city center is essentially the eastern part of the island, with its quaysides, bridges, old warehouses and the narrow alleys of the medieval heart, plus a segment to the north of the River Lee that has MacCurtain Street as its central.

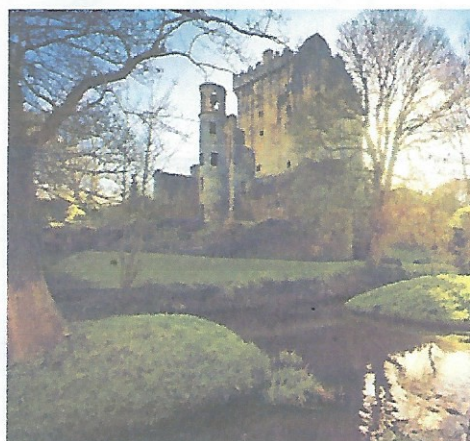

EXPLORE PLYMOUTH

Plymouth is located between the mouths of the rivers Tamar and Plym in what is widely regarded as one of the world's most impressive natural harbors.

The city is a unitary authority responsible for its own decision-making within the historic county of Devon. The area was first recorded in the Domesday book as "Sudtone" (1086; later Sutton) and together with the towns of Devonport and Stonehouse amalgamated in 1914 to form the modern Plymouth which was granted city status in 1928. In 1588, the English Navy, which was led in part by Sir Francis Drake, set sail from Plymouth to defeat the Spanish Armada.

With its dramatic coastal setting, the surrounding landscape is quite striking. Plymouth is by turns rugged and hilly, or green and rolling. Famous Dartmoor was

designated as a National Park in 1951. Popular sites include Smeatons Tower, a lighthouse resited on the Hoe, Mount Batten Peninsula, the National Marine Aquarium, and Buckland Abbey, which was Drake's former home. The Royal Dockyard was built in the area, on the banks of the River Tamar, in 1690.

Plymouth has a long and historic seafaring tradition. It was in 1620 that the Pilgrim Fathers finally left Plymouth after repairs on their escape from religious persecution to the New World, eventually setting up Plymouth Colony, Massachusetts.

Tourism is an important aspect of Plymouth's economy. Nearly 12 million people visit Plymouth every year. As well as all the attractions of a modern city, Plymouth is a popular launchpad to other notable areas including the beaches and

footpaths of the Devon and Cornwall coastline and the brooding landscape of nearby Dartmoor.

The city of Plymouth covers multiple rock types, the Hoe, in the south of the city is composed of Devonian Limestone, which was also used for building a fairly high proportion of the city (most of the older houses and buildings are at least fronted with the stone). The area around the Station is formed of mudstone, which too is Devonian. The outer areas of the city are increasingly higher grades of metamorphosed mudstone, with the occasional pillow lava on hills.

Dartmoor is a massive batholith (big lump) of granite, while Cawsand and Kingsand (reachable by ferry from the Barbican) contain various igneous structures.

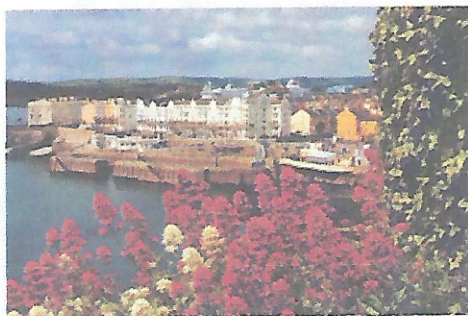

Please wait in the lounge until directed to the gangway on Deck 3. Unless you have difficulty walking, use the stairs to gain access to the tender embarkation platform. Colored tender tickets are required for all guests until the Cruise Director makes an open tendering announcement over the public address system. This will be done once most guests have disembarked. Tenders will then continuously operate from the ship to shore; the time between tenders is approximately every 30 minutes.

For Your Safety: These instructions and guidelines are to improve your safety and comfort. Please familiarize yourself with the procedures:

- Obey all orders given by the tender's crew members; do not try to help in any way unless asked to do so.
- Await instructions from an officer before moving toward the tender platform.
- Do not crowd the landing platform.
- Wait for the signal from the tender's crew to board or exit the tender.
- Step carefully between the ship and the tender. Crew members are positioned at the entrance of the tender to assist you; they will not carry you.
- Both hands must be free when getting on or off the tender. Hand over loose articles to the tender's crew before getting on or off.
- When stepping on or off the tender, extend "forearm to forearm" to the person assisting you. Never grip hands as this immobilizes the helper.
- Never jump on board. Sit down as soon as you can and stand up only when requested to do so.
- Smoking is not permitted on the tenders or while waiting in boarding lines.
